



Accessing the new Elementary Progress Report (EPR)

Parents/Guardians will access the Elementary Progress Report (EPR) through the new EngagED Parent Dashboard at engaged.dcsdk12.org. The EngagED Parent Dashboard is an effort to unify the parent experience and partner with parents/guardians to provide relevant district applications and resources, such as the Elementary Progress Report for our elementary families. Parents/Guardians will access the dashboard using the same username and password from the IC Parent Portal.




